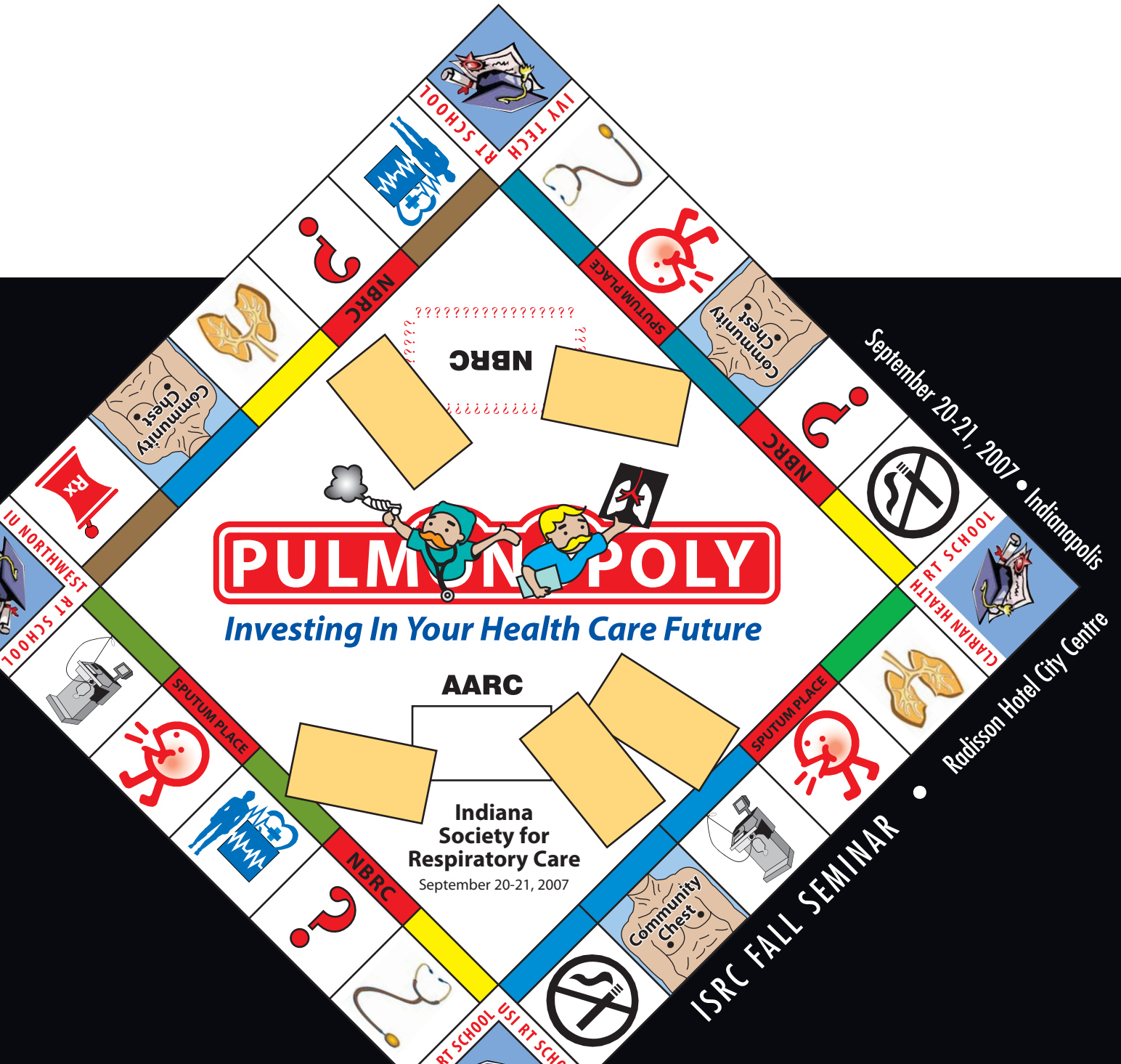


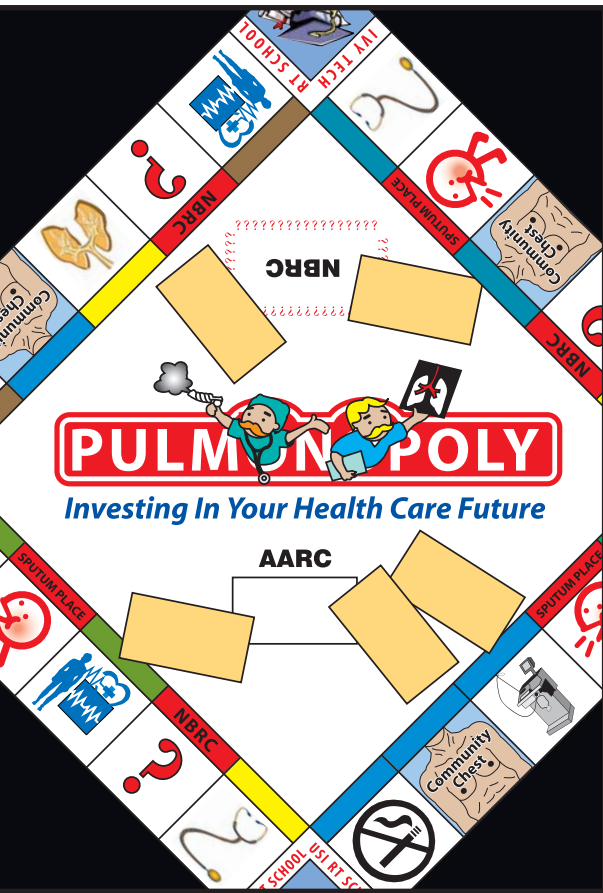

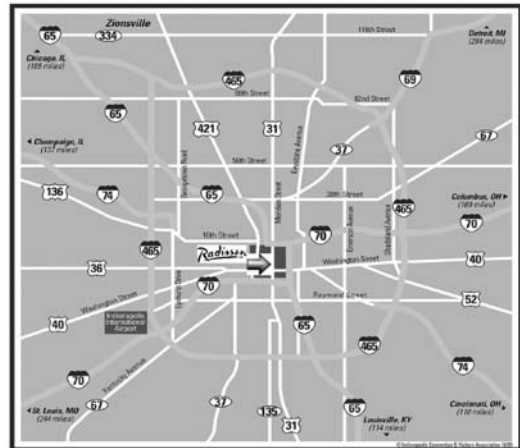
A silent auction will be held Thursday. Proceeds will benefit the ISRC scholarship and educational activities.
